

Workshop conducted on Gender Budgeting from 16th to 18th December, 2015.

Gender Budgeting is a powerful tool for achieving gender mainstreaming so as to ensure that benefits of development reach women as much as men. It is not an accounting exercise but an ongoing process of keeping a gender perspective in policy/ program formulation, its implementation and review. GB entails dissection of the Government budgets to establish its gender differential impacts and to ensure that gender commitments are translated in to budgetary commitments. Pushing for more women in police forces, the Union Ministry of Home Affairs has advised to introduce 'gender budgeting' in allocation of police funds to provide ample facilities and equipment for women police personnel in the state.
