DEPARTMENT OF CRIMINOLOGY & POLICE STUDIES

The Department of Criminology provides postgraduate academic and professionally oriented programmes for aspiring students and practitioners in the field of Criminal Justice. This course is an excellent blend of theoretical and applied criminology as it allows the students to apply their knowledge in criminology in various professions or fields like police services, social work and human rights which are contemporary and emerging fields which have a bright future. The department offers students a wonderful opportunity to acquire experience by interaction with actual practitioners of this field which will help in the practical application of their growing criminological skills and expertise.

COURSE OUTLINE

The curriculum of the course is built on a common foundation of applied criminology and allows for maximum flexibility to meet the needs of the students and their respective areas of interest. In this approach, the courses will be individualised to meet the student's professional goals in keeping with the overall objectives of the programs and practical aspects of the field in terms of employment. The course comprises two years of full time study comprising of 4 semesters.

DURATION AND PROGRAM STRUCTURE

Two years full time program (Semester pattern) Regular classes are complimented with tutorials, field visits and practicals during the course. Guest lectures are given by distinguished speakers including high-profile practitioners including police officers, judges, prosecutors, human rights activists, forensic scientists, social workers and renowned academicians both from India and abroad.

The 1st semester comprises of five papers

- Fundamentals of Criminology
- Criminal Justice System
- Criminal Laws and Procedure
- Theories of crime
- Psychology of Crime

The 2nd semester comprises of five papers

- Penology and Correctional Administration
- Research Methodology in Criminology
- Forensic Science and Medicine
- Victimology

In this semester student can choose their specialisation in various fields. The Department offers specialisation in 2 areas:

- Police Studies & Security Management
- Human Rights

This semester will include an introductory paper in the area of the specialisation.

The 3rd semester - This semester will have four papers in the area of specialisation and a compulsory paper on Police Administration in India.

The 4th Semester - In this semester the students will prepare a dissertation and undergo internship/attachment in various Governmental and Non-Governmental organisations.

The dissertation will typically be on a topic that closely links into career development. Faculty members will provide one to one supervision and direction to the students during their dissertation.

WHO IS IT FOR?

- If one wants to obtain Master's degree as a suitable entry into the criminal justice professions with accurate professional knowledge and skills.
- The one employed in the criminal justice system especially in policing, who wants to acquire job-related knowledge or broaden their perspectives.
- Those interested in a potential academic career with the element of interdisciplinary approach in higher education including doctoral program.

FUTURE PROSPECTS OF THIS COURSE

Within the police force, criminologists can assist in profiling an offender and determining the aftermath of his/her crime. National and International Organisations, Non Governmental Organisations, Police Services, Human Rights Commissions, Police Academies, Correctional Services and Counselling are some other future prospects in Criminology. Criminologists are the need of the hour and the field of criminology has a lot to offer to those who are willing to make a difference.

Graduate in any Discipline having a minimum of 55% for General/OBC and 50% for SC/ST candidates.
