

Cybercrime Challenges for Law Enforcement

A computer's increasing sophistication, in terms of power, capacity and communication speed has offered multifarious opportunities to multiple players including the criminals, law-breakers and terrorists. Therefore, people should have confidence that their data will travel safely to their destination. With the increasing use of the internet during lockdowns (Covid-19), dynamics of cyberspace increases the criminal opportunity for motivated offenders. Cyber threats are significant enough to become a national security priority. It is in this backdrop, that the GCCT has decided to tackle this problem and organizing aWebinar for capacity building of law enforcement senior officials and various stakeholders to counter cyber security threats.

Goal: As stated above, the main objective of the Webinar is to discuss various challenges and practical solutions for enhancing awareness and crime detections skills in the field of cyber crime.

Mode of operation: The GCCT will arrange, coordinate and execute the online Webinar.
